It's always good to ask what wind speed the awnings being quoted are engineered to achieve. This will ensure your peace of mind on those wild and windy nights.
- Roof construction is very important. Whether you choose our Traditional Profile Roof Deck or the Modern “Flat Deck” Roofing, all Ausiports Patio Roof Sheets are Double Sided Colour and offer HIGH GLOSS (80%) Paint Finishes on the underside. This means far greater heat reflection on the top side and far better light retention below, making your new area cooler and lighter.
- The backbone of any structure is the supporting beam. All Ausiports beams are rolled from Hi-Tensile, Australian Made, Bluescope Colorbond Steel. Ausiports offer beams from 75 to 200mm, in varying weights and profiles, engineered for longer spans and high performance.
